

Charter of the charitable organisation Johannes Beese Foundation Unna/Germany

§1

Name, Legal Form, domicile

1.

The name of the foundation is "Johannes Beese Stiftung" (Johannes Beese Foundation).

2.

The Johannes Beese Foundation is a charitable organization having legal capacity based on the rules and by-laws of the German civil law. It is registered in Unna.

§ 2

Aim of the foundation

The aim of the foundation is the child and youth welfare as well as education and formation.

This support is directed towards:

A) Children and youth, who are victims of acts of violence or were in any other way exposed to violent actions, in particular

- As victims of domestic violence
- As victims of armed conflicts and war-like operations
- As victims of sexual abuse

The foundation aims to support the children and youth directly

- 1) by a financial contribution, either as a single payment or a recurrent donation to indigent children and youth; premises for those direct financial aid to children and youth is, that the income of the person and those, who are responsible for the support, does not exceed the limits according to § 53, 2 AO;
- 2) by covering the costs for medical and/or other means, especially medical support, therapies, mentoring and supervision and recuperation;

B) Students from disadvantaged families with low-income

The foundation supports the above aims to those students directs from the foundation funds to promote talented students or within a job training by financing a study visit abroad

The aims, that have just been described, can also be delegated by the foundation to an auxiliary person, when according to the case, by legal formalities, the relation between the foundation and the subsidiary person is such that the subsidiary person acts as if it were executor for the aims of the foundation.

There can be no legal claim on funding from the foundation.
