

Excerpt of the Charter of the charitable organization Johannes Beese Foundation Unna/Germany

§1 Name, Legal Form, domicile

1. The name of the foundation is “Johannes Beese Stiftung” (Johannes Beese Foundation).
2. The Johannes Beese Foundation is a charitable organization having legal capacity based on the rules and by-laws of the German civil law. It is registered in Unna.

§ 2 Aim of the foundation

The aim of the foundation is to support children in need, disadvantaged youth and their mothers.

The aim of the foundation is reached through:

1. Projects and programs supporting children and youth in need who have been victims of violence (i.e. sexual abuse, domestic violence and victims of armed conflicts and war-like operations)
2. Projects and programs supporting children and youth in need and their mothers affected by natural catastrophes, famine and other forms of crisis
3. Projects and programs supporting children and youth in need by providing medical care
4. Projects and programs supporting children and youth in need with so called micro credits
5. Support of children and youth through other projects

The aims, that have just been described, can also be delegated by the foundation to an auxiliary person, when according to the case, by legal formalities, the relation between the foundation and the subsidiary person is such that the subsidiary person acts as if it were executor for the aims of the foundation. There can be no legal claim on funding from the foundation.
